What kind of interpreters are available, sign, oral, cued speech interpreters?

Who coordinates services for interpreters?

What other services and/or programs are available in the community for someone with a hearing loss?

Should I access academic and career counseling from the general counseling offices on campus or here in your office?

Are interpreters available for extracurricular activities?

What hearing loss accommodations systems are available on campus and in the residence halls?

Are there assistive listening devices available in the classroom?

Is CART (Communication Access Real-time Translation) or notetakers available and how are they recruited?

Who does the scheduling and arrangements for CART or notetakers my class?

How should I communicate course absences in relation to accommodations in event of sickness, family emergencies, etc?

Who communicates my accommodations to campus faculty?
